Dallas' Legapalooza Improving Amputees' LivesBy Bruce Vincent

Hundreds of amputees, supporters and partygoers soon will be kicking off another long Texas summer at the annual Legapalooza fundraiser benefitting the amputee community.

Since 2010, this one-of-a-kind event has raised over \$350,000 to help fund the many beneficial programs provided by the non-profit Dallas Amputee Network (DAN), the country's largest and most active amputee support group. This year's Legapalooza is set for Sunday, September 26th at Milo Butterfingers Bar & Grill in Dallas.







"When we started this up several years ago, none of us realized how big it would become," says Legapalooza founder Tommy Donahue, who lost his right leg after being struck by a hit-and-run driver in 1981.

Reluctant Start Brings Support

Tommy joined DAN in 2004 following an invitation from the group's then-director and fellow amputee Ellen Fernandes. Tommy initially told Ellen he did not need a support group. But when she explained that DAN needed him as much as he needed them, he realized DAN represented his chance to make a difference in the lives of other amputees.

"One of the first things I did as a DAN member was to become a certified peer visitor, which is one of the many great programs supported by Legapalooza," Tommy says.

Under the program, DAN provides a 24-hour hotline to organize visits from ACA-certified peer visitors with amputees, candidates for amputation and their families at local hospitals and their homes.

DAN also is responsible for sending more delegates to the annual Amputee Coalition of America National Conference than any other support group in the nation. DAN sent more than 30 members to the last conference and an even larger group is planned for the next conference.

DAN also holds monthly meetings where members gather to share their accomplishments and set goals for improving their lives together.







Legapalooza Gets Its Legs

Tommy previously hosted Legapalooza as a simple party for several years before deciding to turn it into a charity event. After signing up his personal prosthetist at M-Power Prosthetics & Orthotics in Dallas as an original sponsor, additional support came rolling in. Today, Legapalooza's sponsors also include prosthetic companies Endolite, Fillauer, LIM and WillowWood, as well as many local businesses.

"Our incredible sponsors and dedicated volunteers are what make Legapalooza work," Tommy says. "Without them this thing would still be nothing more than a loud, fun party."

And no doubt, it will be another loud fun time this year. In addition to live and silent auctions featuring everything from autographed sports and music memorabilia to vacation packages to dinners at local restaurants, Legapalooza also will include live musical performances throughout the day and a variety of food vendors.

"Last year's Legapalooza accounted for more than one-fourth of the money we've raised to benefit DAN over the years, and we're expecting to do even better this year," Tommy says. "Our goal is to make sure that DAN continues to provide first-rate services that help all amputees."
